



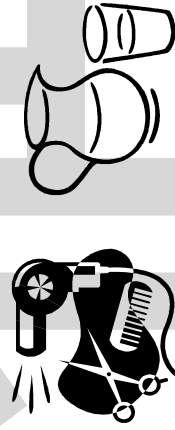

## How It Works

Interfaith Food Bank Garage Sale accepts new and gently used household items from the public, or through a reclamation process, then marks them for sale at garage sale prices.

We use volunteers to man the store, sort and test appliances, and display items for sale.

Interfaith Garage Sale helps to turn non-food items into funds that can be used for food and other program costs. Aside from being a fund-raising initiative for Interfaith Food Bank, the Garage Sale also offers the public, as well as families we serve, the opportunity to purchase household items, gifts and other products at affordable prices.

**Interfaith Food Bank is non-profit, charitable organization that is reliant upon community support to offer our programs and services.**

## How To Donate

Non-food and household items can be brought to *Donations and Administration* at Interfaith Food Bank. We prefer new, or lightly used household items, and prefer items that are likely to generate revenue and sell quickly.

Unfortunately, we do not pickup garage sale items.

### Donations that are always welcome:

- Dishes, Glassware and Cookware
- Small Appliances such as toasters, blenders, coffee pots
- Books and Trinkets



### Due to limited space on our sales floor, we are unable to accept:

- Furniture
- Clothing
- Large Appliances
- Electronics or computers
- Textbooks or encyclopedias



## How To Purchase

Interfaith Garage Sale is open to the public, as well as to the families we serve.

The Garage Sale operates weekdays only for the majority of the year, although occasionally we will open for additional hours on Saturdays during the summer or leading into Christmas.

Method of payment: **Cash Only**. We do not barter or trade items at any time.

Purchases are **not subject to GST**.
